1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 Paddock regulations

1.2 Damages

1.4 Driving permit for Sunday

1.5 Additional overnight stay at the Hockenheimring

For participants who cannot leave before 6th of May 2024, there is the possibility to use a parking space in the Contikreis (area across the paddock entrance). Because the areas and pits will already be used by the next organizer, the paddock has to be cleared latest by Sunday, 5th of May 2024 – 8 pm.



2. PADDOCK

2.1 Paddock entry and exit

Paddock clearance:	Sunday, 5th of May 2024	until 8 pm

If you are arriving at the Hockenheimring before the defined entry times, we will set up a sufficient space for you to wait.

2.2 Motorhomes / trailers

Motorhomes and empty car trailers have to be brought out of the paddock to designated areas (see attachment 4 "Paddock plan").

2.3 Electronic pit keys

The pit keys will be handed out at the Sachs-Haus by Sylvia Jasberenyi. The deposit per key is 100€. The deposit will be given back to you when you return the key. Use an online reader to activate the electronic pit key. This activation lasts until the following day at 11:59 pm. The key must then be reactivated.

4. DOCUMENT CHECK

Document checks for all series will take place on Thursday in the Sachs-Haus and on Friday in the RAVENOL tower. All the documents required for participation in the event will be given to you. Please bring your license and your registration documents with you.

What you need for the document check:

- Valid driver's license
- Valid applicant license (if applicants are present), if required an original power of attorney with a copy of the license (in the case of international applicant licenses, an applicant license must be submitted, which shows the right of representation)
- International starting permits for international participants who don't have a license from the DMSB

5. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

- German participants: valid DMSB/FIA car pass
- International participants: valid car pass from the relevant international sports authority (ASN)
- Mandatory safety equipment
- For historic cars according to Appendix K, a Historic Technical Passport (HTP) from the responsible ASN is required

7. TIME KEEPING / TRANSPONDER

8. TEST DAY

The Badische Motorsport Club e.V. offers a test day on Thursday, 2nd of May 2024. The test day has no noise restrictions and been held under noise category A. The participants are divided into different groups. Tickets for participation can be purchased on 2nd of May 2024 starting from 7 am at the Sachs-Haus. After your payment you will receive a sticker, which you have to fix visibly on the front part of your car. **ATTENTION: The number of starters per group is limited!**
